

Abstract submission instructions

All participants are invited to submit **abstracts** to be presented as oral or poster presentations at the meeting. We would further like to invite everyone to submit **case reports** about “**Cancer treatment in pregnancy**” to be presented during the meeting.

The abstract deadline is **April 15th, 2017** and those received by this date will be published in Reproductive Toxicology if accepted. Abstracts received after that date will be distributed at the meeting. Please make sure that your abstract has been 'spell checked' and 'grammar checked' before submitting it.

Abstract template:

- Authors names in bold, with surname first followed by full first name and second initial, and presenting author indicated with asterisk after surname.
- Affiliation in italics, name of institute, place and country only. Multiple affiliations indicated by superscript numbers and matched with superscript numbers after surnames.
- One line spacing before body text.
- Abstract body in plain text in one paragraph, no indents or empty lines. No figures or tables.
- Up to three references acceptable, indicated by numbers in square brackets in line with the text. The reference format of Reproductive Toxicology should be used (<http://www.elsevier.com/journals/reproductive-toxicology/0890-6238/guide-for-authors#68000>).
- Organize text in: introduction, methods, results and conclusions.
- Provide factual text. Avoid general statements like: "results will be presented".
- Use 300 up to a maximum of 500 words for complete abstract text (including title, authors, affiliation and body text).
- Add preference choice for poster or oral presentation.
